We are committed to making A Boundless Summer as inclusive as possible.

Site description

Our sites have one main stage. Both sites have wheelchair access, however it should be noted that they are greenfield sites, and some areas of the grounds at the event site are uneven, so special care should be taken while moving around the site. Specific distances from accessible parking to the main stage will be available nearer the time of the event.

A complimentary ticket is available to a Personal Assistant should this be required. Please call the Ticketmaster accessibility team on 0800 988 4440 to purchase your ticket and to organise the Personal Assistant complimentary ticket.

Accessible parking

There will be accessible parking at the events. Information on accessible drop off point and site maps, will be available nearer the time of the event.

Accessible toilets

Accessible toilets will be available on both sites (for which RADAR locks will be used) and these will be well signposted. Site maps showing accessible toilet provision will be available on the website nearer the time of the event.

Assistance dogs

Please note that assistance dogs will be permitted on site.

Strobe lighting

There will be no strobe lighting at the events.

Arrival guide

Doors open at 5pm on all events, apart from 22nd July when doors open at 5.30pm. An early entrance option can be requested via access@boundlesssummer.co.uk.

FAQs

Are child tickets available?

Yes, discounted tickets are available for 5 ? 15 year olds, and under 5s are free.

What is the Golden Circle?

The Golden Circle is a separate area closer to the stage, with more space and access to a separate bar.

Will there be parking?

Yes, there will be ample on-site parking available at each event.

What picnic items can be brought in?

Picnic blankets and camping seats can be brought in but no gazebos or umbrellas. For food and drink restrictions please see questions below.

Can I bring food and drink into the Borde Hill Garden concerts (7 and 8 July)?

No food and drink can be brought into the venue. There will be a wide variety of bars and food vendors on site, catering to many dietary requirements, open from 5pm.

Can I bring food and drink into the Bowood House concerts (21 and 22 July)?

Although you are welcome to bring your own food and drink (restrictions will apply), there will be a wide variety of bars and good quality food vendors on site open from 5pm on 21 July, and 5.30pm on 22 July. Please note that barbecues are not permitted anywhere on site.

What disability access is provided at the concerts?

A complimentary ticket is available to a personal assistant should this be required. Please call the Ticketmaster accessibility team on 0800 988 4440 to purchase your ticket and to organise the personal assistant complimentary ticket.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING:

Please follow the signs upon arrival to the disabled parking area.

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS:

Accessible toilets will be available on both sites (for which RADAR locks will be used) and these will be well signposted.

What are the timings for the events?

7th, 8th, 21 July: Gates open 5pm, support artist: 7.15-8.00pm, headline artist: 8.30pm, Ends 10pm (approx) 22 July: Gates open 5.30pm, support artist: 6.30-7.15pm, Katherine Jenkins: 7.30pm-8.15pm and 8.45-10pm (approx). Please note that all times are subject to change without notice.

I have an enquiry regarding my tickets, who do I speak to?

You need to contact the ticket agency that you purchased your ticket from. Tickets must not be used for re-sale, promotion or other commercial gain.

If I leave the concert can I get back in?

No, there is no re-entry into the concert.

What time is the last entry into the concert?

Last entry is 8.45pm ? we don't want you to miss out so please make sure you arrive with sufficient time.

Can I bring a dog to the concert?

Dogs are not permitted at the concerts. Assistance dogs, however, will be allowed.

Can I bring a camera?

Non-professional cameras are allowed for personal use, but professional recording equipment and cameras (ie SLR or DSLR) will not be permitted onsite.

Can I smoke at the concerts?

You can smoke in the open air but not inside tents. Please dispose of your butts responsibly.

Are there any age restrictions?

Everyone aged 5 or over will require a ticket to gain entry but children under 5 go free. All under 18s must be accompanied by a ticket holder aged 18 or over.

What happens if it rains?

The concerts will always go ahead in the event of bad weather. Please check the weather forecast in advance and be prepared for the Great British Summer and bring appropriate clothing. The concerts take place on greenfield sites so can become muddy. Please note, umbrellas are not allowed on site as they will restrict the views for other guests.

Are there cashpoints on site?

Unfortunately, there are no ATM services at the concerts but all food and drink vendors will take cards on the day.

Can I download a site map?

Not yet, but they will be available to download from this website closer to the concerts.

Although both sites have wheelchair access, it should be noted that they are greenfield sites, and some areas of the grounds at the event site are uneven so special care should be taken while moving around the site.
